## GUEST ARTISTS

Ukrainian violinist Liubomyr Senyshyn began his violin studies at age 6, not realizing that music would become his calling in life. After graduating with his MM from L'viv National Music Academy (Ukraine) in 2014 at the age of 24, he joined K&K Philharmoniker, a reputable young orchestra based in Austria that performs through Europe. With K&K, he played over 120 concerts per year in renowned concert halls in Europe: Berliner Philharmonic, Wiener Musikverein and Oslo Opera House.

Senyshyn's accomplishments include his participation in the Kiev Music Festival (2009, 2010) and the Cremona International Music Academy (2016, 2017). He has taken master classes with world famous violinists Paula Tumeo (Italy), Felix Andrievsky (UK), Roberto Cani (USA), and Jela Spikova (Austria).

Liubomyr enjoys being an avid chamber musician. He was a member of KLMB String Quartet for 3 years based in Ukraine and he was a co-founder of the Glenside Quartet (Boston, MA). He maintains an active private teaching studio in the Boston area.

Liubomyr Senyshyn is currently a Graduate Performance Diploma Candidate at the Longy School of Music of Bard College studying under Mark Lakirovich. One of his greatest contributions as a student at Longy is collaborating with Boston Opera Collaborative, working on three major productions. He maintains an active professional performance schedule with several Boston area orchestras: Cape Ann Symphony, Boston Chamber Symphony Orchestra, and Boston Philharmonic Orchestra. He is a winner of the 2017 Honors Competitions at Longy School of Music and placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in the International Music Competition for Strings (Cremona, Italy) in summer 2017.
